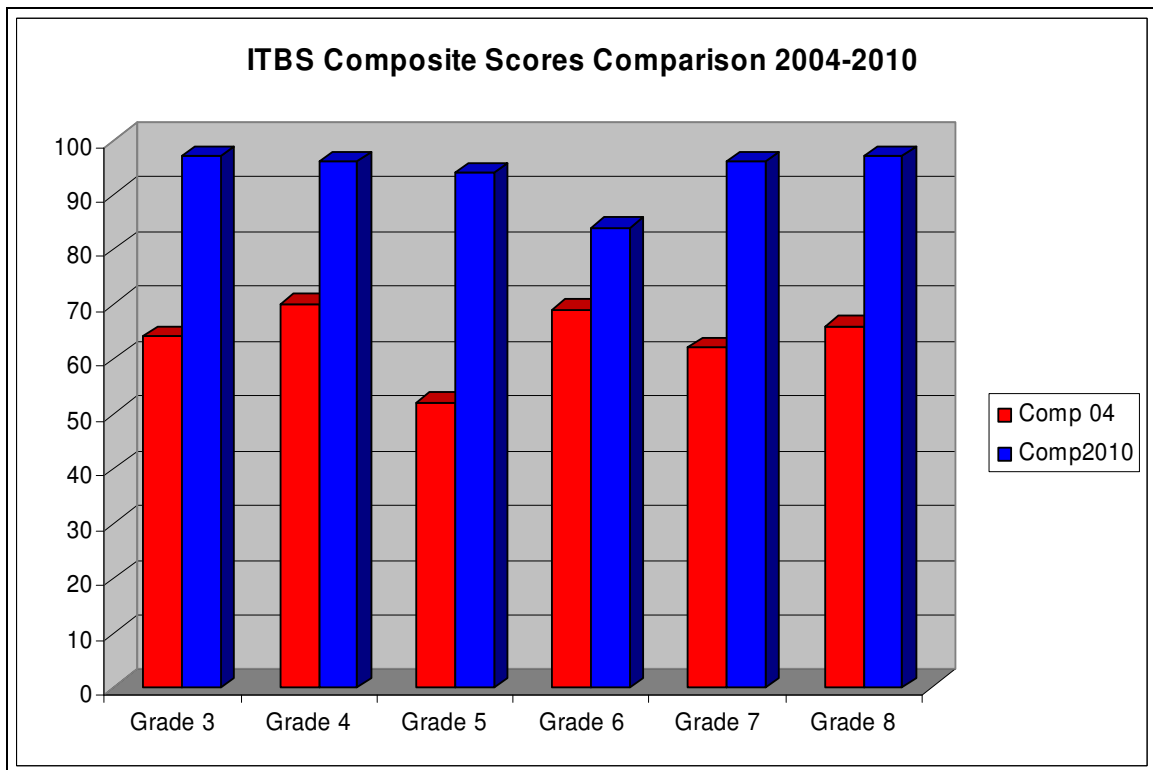


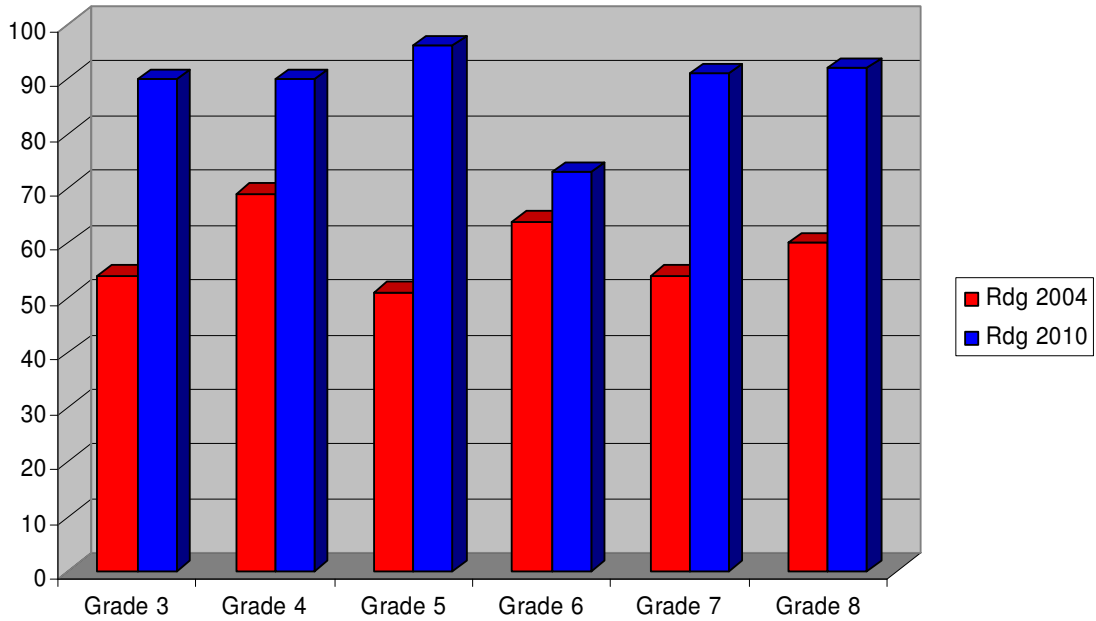
Koraes Iowa Test of Basic Skills Comparison 2004-2010

The ITBS Tests are standardized achievement tests that are taken by children all over the nation. The main purpose of the ITBS is to provide the school with information that can be used to improve instruction and to help teachers make sound educational decisions about each student's learning. The scores allow us to check each student's year-to-year growth and to identify each child's strongest and weakest area of achievement. The skills being tested are closely aligned with Illinois State Academic Frameworks and Benchmarks.

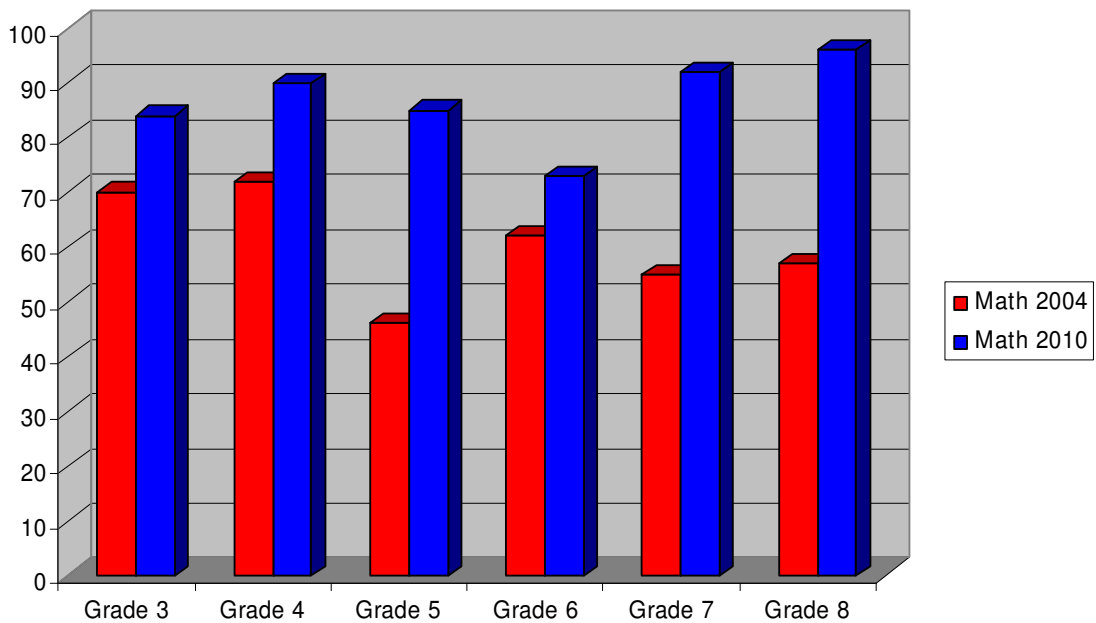

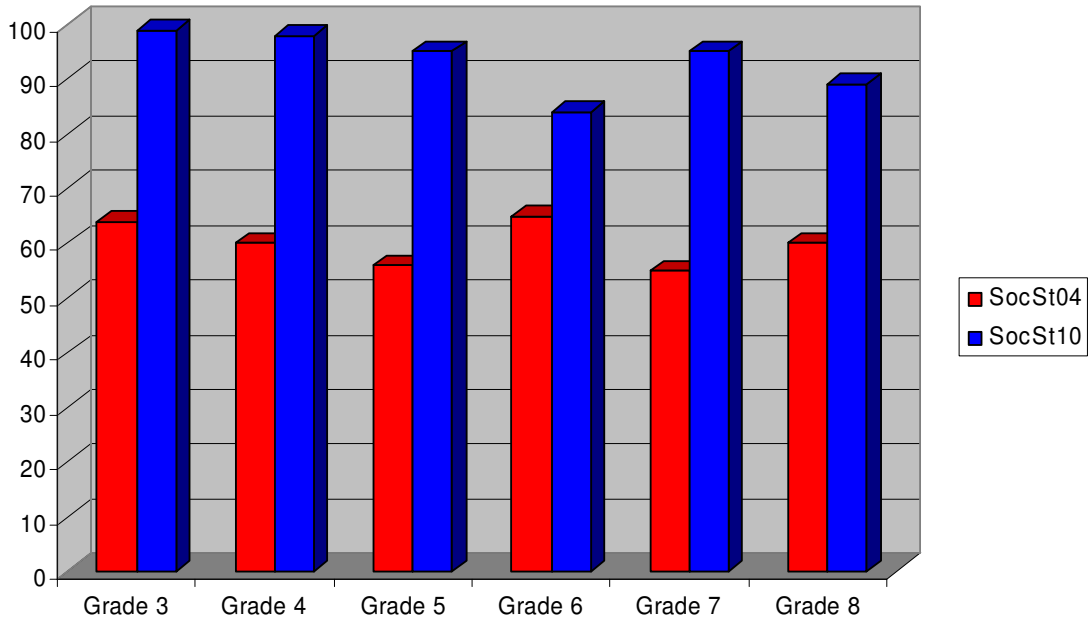
ITBS Reading Scores Comparison 2004-2010
