

eLearning days will be used when school is closed due to inclement weather.

How will students and parents be notified if an eLearning day will be used in the case of emergency school cancellation?

Families will be notified of eLearning days just as they are notified of school delays and closings via our website and Facebook and email.

What will it look like for students?

Student work will be located in Google Classroom for grades 3-8. Teachers for grades PK - 2 will email parents work and activities for the day. The assignments will not use programming or apps that students are not familiar with or have not already used in class before.

What happens if my child needs assistance?

Teachers will be available to students through their school email for immediate email response 8:45AM-10:00AM. They will be intermittently available through email from 10:00AM until 3:30PM.

When will eLearning day assignments get posted?

Work for students will be posted by 8:45AM during emergency school cancellation days. For scheduled eLearning days, assignments will be posted by 8:00 pm the previous day. Assignments will be graded and recorded. Consideration will be given to students that need additional time due to unforeseen circumstances.

Why have eLearning days?

Having the technical and organizational skills necessary to do independent, online learning is important for our students.

How will attendance be taken?

Students must answer an attendance question for each class they have a different teacher. If a student does not answer the attendance question for that class he will be marked absent. If a student is ill and cannot participate, parents should email the teacher to inform him/her the child is taking a sick day. Students are still responsible for completing the assignment.
